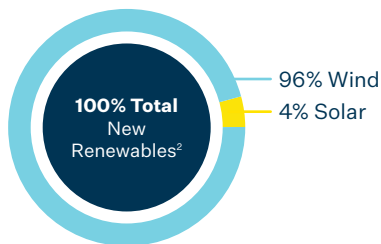


2026 Green FutureSM Choice and Green Future Block prospective product content label¹



Green Future Choice matches 73% of your monthly electricity use. Green Future Block is sold in 200 kilowatt-hour (kWh) blocks. These are Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) products and do not contain electricity, which is billed separately.

A REC represents the environmental benefits of 1 megawatt-hour (MWh) of renewable energy that can be paired with electricity. For more information about RECs, see www.green-e.org/rec.

Portland General Electric

What is my contract length?	Your Green Future Choice and/or Green Future Block contract is month-to-month.
How will I be billed?	Your Green Future Choice and/or Green Future Block charge will be listed as a separate line item on your monthly PGE bill. This charge is in addition to your regular electricity bill.
How much will Green Future Choice cost?	Green Future Choice costs \$0.0094/kWh in addition to your Basic Service rates. Green Future Choice will match 73% of your monthly electricity use.
How much will Green Future Block cost?	\$1.88 per 200 kWh block of Green Future Block. You can purchase as many "blocks" as you'd like, with a minimum purchase of one block.
Will my rates change over time?	Green Future Choice and Green Future Block prices are based on current Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) approved tariffs. Pricing is subject to change. All price changes require approval from the OPUC. You will be notified of any price change in advance.
What other fees might I be charged?	You must also pay all applicable federal, state or local taxes.
Can I cancel my participation?	You can cancel at any time with no fee. There is no minimum contract length.

1. These figures reflect the renewables that we have contracted to provide. Actual figures may vary from those filed with Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) according to resource availability. Wind and solar percentages could vary +/- 10%. We will annually report to you before August 1 of next year in the form of a Historic Product Content Label the actual resource mix of the electricity you purchased.
2. New renewables come from generation facilities that first began commercial operation within the past 15 years. These percentages are averaged annually.
3. These figures are based on generated and purchased energy associated with serving retail customers within the state of Oregon, as required by ODEQ. Some or all of the renewable energy attributes associated with PGE's Basic Service Mix may be sold, claimed, or not acquired.
4. Hydro includes power purchased from Bonneville Power Administration (BPA).
5. Per ODEQ rules, unspecified purchases represent purchased power for which a specific generating resource is not known and could be any of the generation types (e.g. wind, hydro, gas). Other purchases may include biomass, biomass gases, landfill gas or other fuel types.

Green Future Choice is approved by ODEQ to generate incremental Clean Fuels Program credits as set forth in OAR 340-253-0470. Residential Green Future Choice participants who charge an electric vehicle at home also support transportation electrification programs that benefit residential utility customers.
